Lower Your Energy Bills with FREE Home Improvement Services



Elevate Energy, Neighborhood Housing Services, community groups, and the City of Chicago provide FREE energy efficiency improvements to qualified homeowners in targeted neighborhoods throughout the city. The FREE improvements are made possible by the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development and the City of Chicago.

The program makes upgrades that address health and safety issues like mold and asbestos in addition to lowering energy use. Typical improvements may include:

- Sealing areas where heated air escapes the house
- Adding insulation in the roof cavity
- Replacing old furnaces and hot water heaters
- Insulating pipes
- Fixing small roof leaks
- Properly venting clothes dryers
- Encapsulating asbestos
- Sealing chimney to prevent leaking
- Covering electrical boxes
- Replacing toilets
- Installing bathroom fans
- Replacing broken windows
- Installing programmable thermostats, carbon monoxide detectors, and smoke detectors
- Adding weather stripping and door sweeps to exterior doors



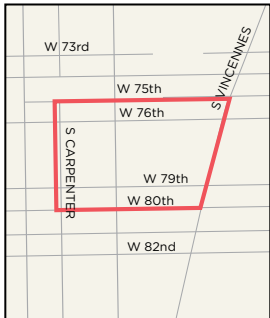
See If You Qualify

To qualify for the program, applicants must:

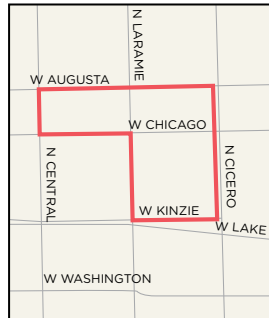
- Own and live in a home with no more than 4 apartment units
- The home must be located in a targeted neighborhood (see maps below)
- Have homeowners insurance
- Be current on the mortgage
- Not owe money to the City of Chicago (no unpaid parking tickets, water bills, taxes, etc.)
- Meet income requirements (see table below)
